SUMMER CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY:

Construction is about to begin on **Idaho 21** along a two-mile stretch from Diversion Dam to Sandy Point as well as from its junction with I-84 at exit 57 to about 50 feet northeast of the westbound Federal Way (Idaho 21) off ramp.

Starting July 13, the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) will rehabilitate the pavement in these areas, significantly extending the life of the roadway and creating a smoother ride for motorists.

In addition, multiple video detection cameras will be installed for both north and southbound traffic at the Gowen Road/Idaho 21 intersection through a cooperative agreement with ACHD.

A portion of the bike path running parallel with the northbound lane from Diversion Dam toward Sandy Point will also be improved. The bike path will be closed for three to five days during this work, and every effort will be made to re-open the path as soon as possible.
