SUMMER CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY:

Construction is about to begin on Five Mile Bridge over Interstate 84 between Franklin and Overland on Five Mile Road.

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) will repair the bridge deck and resurface the deteriorated pavement *beginning July 13* and lasting approximately 25 days.

In order to make these improvements quickly and efficiently, the bridge **will be closed** during construction. The closure enables construction crews to complete the project two weeks earlier. It also saves money. ITD advises that motorists use alternate routes.

Five Mile Bridge was built in 1966. It carries more than 18,000 vehicles a day. By 2031, average daily traffic is projected to exceed 19,250.

This project will extend the life of the structure and provide a smoother ride for motorists.
